How many body bags will it take before the American people wipe their smirk off their face?


Whether the Ebola virus will end up killing thousands, millions or billions of people - the seriousness hasn't sunk into the general population.


Every day an Ebola joke is told at work whenever someone coughs or sneezes.

RSV Isaiah 22:12-14

12 In that day the <u>Lord God of hosts called to weeping and mourning</u>, to baldness and girding with sackcloth;

13 and behold, joy and gladness, slaying oxen and killing sheep, eating flesh and drinking wine. "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die."

14 The Lord of hosts has revealed himself in my ears: "Surely this iniquity will not be forgiven you till you die," says the Lord God of hosts.

What will it take before the "funny" people wake up and begin repenting?

King David sinned when he took an illegal census and a plague began. King David repented, took responsibility and built an alter to God to stop the plague - 1 Chronicles 21:16-19

RSV 1 Chronicles 21:16-19

16 And David lifted his eyes and saw the angel of the Lord standing between earth and heaven, and in his hand a drawn sword stretched out over Jerusalem. Then **David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces**.

17 And **David said to God**, "Was it not I who gave command to number the people? It is I who have sinned and done very wickedly. But these sheep, what have they done? Let thy hand, I pray

thee, O Lord my God, be against me and against my father's house; but let not the plague be upon thy people."

- 18 Then the angel of the Lord commanded Gad to say to David that David should go up and rear an altar to the Lord on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 19 So David went up at Gad's word, which he had spoken in the name of the Lord.

The politicians are not humbling and repenting before Jesus. That's alright with Jesus. Jesus has additional punishments for disobedient nations as seen in Leviticus 26:21-25

## RSV Leviticus 26:21-25

- 21 "Then if you walk contrary to me, and will not hearken to me, I will bring more plagues upon you, sevenfold as many as your sins.
- 22 And I will let loose the wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children, and destroy your cattle, and make you few in number, so that your ways shall become desolate.
- 23 "And if by this discipline you are not turned to me, but walk contrary to me,
- 24 then I also will walk contrary to you, and I myself will smite you sevenfold for your sins.
- 25 And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall execute vengeance for the covenant; and if you gather within your cities I will send pestilence among you, and you shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.

The salvation that Jesus has extended is found in many places of the bible. 1Kings8:37-40 is one of the places which speak about plagues and how to stop it: prayer, supplication & affliction of heart.

## RSV 1 Kings 8:37-40

- 37 "If there is famine in the land, if there is pestilence or blight or mildew or locust or caterpillar; if their enemy besieges them in any of their cities; whatever plague, whatever sickness there is;
- 38 whatever **prayer**, **whatever supplication** is made by any man or by all thy people Israel, each knowing the affliction of his own heart and stretching out his hands toward this house;
- 39 then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and act, and render to each whose heart thou knowest, according to all his ways (for thou, thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men);
- 40 that they may fear thee all the days that they live in the land which thou gavest to our fathers.

Only a remnant will return to Jesus. Looking in the book of revelation the people did not repent (Rev9:20-21) even when Jesus could stop it. Instead of repenting they cursed the name of God (Rev16:9)

## RSV Revelation 9:20-21

- 20 The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, **did not repent** of the works of their hands nor give up worshiping demons and idols of gold and silver and bronze and stone and wood, which cannot either see or hear or walk;
- 21 nor did they repent of their murders or their sorceries or their immorality or their thefts.

RSV Revelation 16:9 men were scorched by the fierce heat, and they cursed the name of God who had power over these plagues, and they did not repent and give him glory.

Repent America, Repent for the hand of God is upon this nation and on this world.
